

WEEE Regulations differ in Canada as each province has the right to implement its own regulations regarding waste electrical and electronic equipment. Several provinces have WEEE legislation in place. The Electronic Products Recycling Association (EPRA) is an industry-led, not-for-profit organization which operates regulated recycling programs for waste electronics across Canada. All manufacturers, retailers, and distributors of electronic products in provinces with EPR regulations are required to be active in an approved product stewardship plan. They must register, submit reports and pay membership fees to a product stewardship plan. Currently, businesses with a physical presence in Canada and those who sell products via distance selling techniques are required to register in those provinces with EPR regulations in place.
